A Year in Review...

From September 2019 through March 2020, Accent Pontiac implemented robust during and after-school programming for students in Pontiac, Michigan.

- 2 schools served
- 4 guest artist experiences
- 20 student performances
- 280 students served in music classes each week
- 750 students served through music exposure

In March, Accent Pontiac transitioned to respond to the needs of Accent Pontiac families during the COVID-19 pandemic. Since March, Accent Pontiac has served approximately 40 families with virtual music instruction and weekly deliveries of groceries, household items and educational activities.
