2021-2022 HIGHLIGHTS

Relaunch

In September 2021, Accent Pontiac relaunched in-person during and afterschool programming with our partner schools in the Pontiac School District after 18 months of alternative programming during the COVID-19 pandemic. With this relaunch, Accent Pontiac's capacity returned to being able to serve approximately 250 Pontiac students with high quality music instruction.

Expansion

In September 2021, Accent Pontiac expanded our partnership with the Pontiac School District to serve 6th - 8th grade students at Pontiac Middle School. With this expansion, Accent Pontiac was able to continue to serve students who joined the program in 2016 as elementary schoolers when they entered middle school.

New Partnerships

In the 2021 - 2022 school year, Accent Pontiac secured new partnerships with M1 Mobility, SevaTruck, and Calvary Lutheran Church, allowing us to offer full meals and transportation support for after-school program participants.

New Office

In October 2021, Accent Pontiac moved our office location to the Flagstar Strand Theatre in downtown Pontiac. Accent Pontiac is proud to be located in the heart of Pontiac!



IMPACT

82% Musical growth goals on brass, woodwind and percussion instruments were reached by 82% of student participants.

Accent Pontiac students saw an average of 12% growth across the areas of self-awareness, interpersonal skills, social awareness, decision making, and self-management.


